1. herbivores and carnivores

herbivores	carnivores
Animals that eat plants are called herbivores. Example - cow, sheep, goat etc.	Animals that eat the flesh of other animals are called carnivores. Example - tiger, lion etc.

2. pet animals and domestic animals

pet animals	domestic animals
Animals that we keep in our homes because we love them.	Animals that we keep in our homes or farms.
They may or may not be of any use to us. Example - dog, cat etc.	They are useful to us. Example - cow, horse etc.

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Define the following terms :

1. scavengers

Animals like the vulture and hyena do not hunt. They eat the flesh of dead animals or the leftovers of the meat eaters. Such animals are called scavengers.

2. How can you take care of the animals around you?

We should take care of the animals in the following ways:
